L3 MAS to Support Thales Under the Royal Canadian Navy's AJISS Program

MIRABEL, Quebec, September 6, 2017 – L3 MAS announced today that it will be supporting Thales in a key role on its recently announced In-Service Support (ISS) contract for both the Arctic Offshore Patrol Ships (AOPS) and Joint Support Ships (JSS).
